## ◇ Introducing Kobe University

### ○ University overview

Established as a higher education institution in 1902, Kobe University's history spans over 110 years. It is now a national university with 10 faculties, 15 graduate schools, 2 research organizations, and many centers.

Reflecting the cosmopolitan atmosphere of Kobe City, Kobe University has always placed a great emphasis on academic exchange with overseas universities across a wide range of fields and has attained a high academic reputation. The university boasts a collaborative learning and research environment that enables diverse students and staff from different specialized fields to work together.

### ○ International Exchanges

The university has concluded academic exchange agreements with 374 prestigious universities and institutions from 64 countries worldwide, and continues to actively conduct both academic and student exchanges.

## ◇ Outline and characteristics of the course for Teacher Training Students

### ○ Characteristics of the program

In addition to classroom training, students on the course obtain practical teaching experience. They also have the chance to visit public facilities and participate in Japanese cultural events in the region.

### ○ Total number of students to be accepted: 1

### ○ Course Outline

- Japanese language education

(1) Program duration : October, 2022 – March, 2023

(2) Contents : For the first 6 months, students will take Japanese Studies and Fundamental Japanese Language Study at Kobe University's Center for International Education.

- Specialized Training

(1) Program duration: April, 2023 – March, 2024

(2) Contents : Students will attend the required lectures and conduct research under the guidance of a supervising professor. Under the assistance and guidance of their supervisor, some teacher-trainees may be able to conduct research at a public school in Kobe city.

Apr. to Mid-Aug : Spring Semester classes

Mid-Aug. to Sep. : Vacation (Regional exchange events, etc.)

Oct-to Mid-Feb. : Fall Semester

Dec. : Submit reports

Feb. : Research Presentation

Mar. : Completion ceremony

• Practical training, participatory subjects such as field trips and regional exchanges are part of the classes.

• Students will also participate in other activities such as visiting schools and public facilities (e.g. museums).
