Lesson topic

This class aims to improve comprehensive Japanese skills (4 skills) for intermediate level students.

Lesson target

To be able to understand and use intermediate level vocabulary, sentence patterns, and expressions.

Syllabus and plan

The syllabus may be revised subject to circumstance. Please keep yourself up-to-date with information provided in class.

This class is a series of lessons taking place on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Students will learn one unit of the textbook "Minna no Nihongo Intermediate Level I" over three lessons. This class (Intermediate Japanese I, Tuesday) will focus on the "Grammar and Practice (L1, L3, L5)" part of the textbook.

*Intermediate Japanese IA-III: 3 classes per week for 8 weeks (45 hours at total per quarter)

Evaluation method

Students will be assessed on scores of the final assignment (40%), the weekly assignments (Preparation sheets 15%, Exercise sheets 25%) and their participation and performance in class (20%).

Evaluation baseline

Students should be able to understand and use intermediate level vocabulary, sentence patterns, and expressions.

*70% minimum attendance is required for evaluation; those who fail to meet this mandatory requirement will be automatically graded "F"(fail). Students are expected to attend the class at least more than two times a week.

Target students:

This class is an intermediate level Japanese class. Students who wish to register for this class must have completed "Upper Elementary Japanese IB-II B" or obtained "Intermediate Level" in the GEC-JTest.

Exchange students (special auditing students) can register for this course.

Related classes:

1. It is strongly recommended to also take "Intermediate Japanese IIA・IIIA". If you cannot take "Intermediate Japanese IIA・IIIA", it is recommended for students to catch up the class by individual study.
2. After taking this class, it is recommended to take "Intermediate Japanese IB-III B".

Review and preparation

1. Please obtain the textbooks before the class begins (see below).
2. For effective language study, it is recommended for students to review every lesson.

Kobe University requires 45 hours of study from to award one credit, including both inclass instructions as well as study outside classes. Students are required to prepare for each class and complete the review after each class, depending on the respective class goals.
