1. Read and write 135 Kanji at intermediate level
2. Use around 630 in total (including elementary and upper elementary levels) and related vocabulary appropriately in sentences.

Syllabus and plan

Course Format

This course is conducted face to face.

Course Description and Schedule

Students will study kanji, vocabulary, and their usage.

At the beginning of each class, kanji reading and writing quizzes based on the previous lesson will be conducted.

Assignments will also be given throughout the course.

Ability to use kanji and related vocabulary appropriately (evaluated through assignments and class participation).
Attendance alone is not sufficient to pass the course. Active participation and a minimum score of 60% on each quiz and exam are required.

Target Students

This course is designed for intermediate level Japanese learners.
Students are strongly recommended to have completed Upper-Elementary Japanese Kanji and Vocabulary AB or to possess equivalent proficiency (Intermediate level on the CIE J Test).
Since this course assumes prior knowledge of upper-elementary level kanji, students who have not yet reached this level are advised to take the upper-elementary course first.

Related Courses

After completing this course, students are encouraged to enroll in Intermediate Japanese Kanji and Vocabulary B.
Exchange students (special auditing students) are eligible to register.

Review and preparation

Preparation and Review

Students are required to study outside of class.
They must practice writing and review the kanji and vocabulary taught in class before the next lesson in preparation for quizzes.

Assignments must also be submitted as instructed.
