Lesson topic

Improving practical language use by deepening the knowledge regarding Japanese grammar.

Lesson target

Becoming able to discuss topics regarding one's own field of study/research in Japanese.
Acquiring the key knowledge and experience necessary for analyzing Japanese sentences.

Syllabus and plan

※This course is provided in the form of in-person classes.

Students will improve practical Japanese language use by deepening their knowledge regarding Japanese grammar. They will also develop the ability to handle issues concerning one's field of study/research.

This class consists of the following activities.

- 1) Lecture on target grammatical items
- 2) Practice
- 3) Reproduction of texts (Dictogloss) ※

The class schedule is as follows:

(*The schedule may be revised according to participants' needs.)

※Dicto-gloss requires students to listen and reproduce sentences. While looking at a list of given vocabulary, students should reproduce sentences accurately without taking notes. This exercise increases the student's awareness of correct grammar in constructing sentences.

Class 3 (4/28) : Case and focus particles①, Quiz

Class 4 (5/ 7) ※: Case and focus particles②, Dictogloss

Class 5 (5/12) : Case and focus particles③, Quiz

Class 6 (5/19) : Transitive/Intransitive verbs①, Dictogloss

Class 7 (5/26) : Transitive/Intransitive verbs②, Quiz

Class 8 (6/ 2) : Review and Examination

8 classes (15 hours).

Evaluation method

Evaluation components:

- scores of the examination (40%)
- class participation(30%)
- scores of quiz and dictogloss(15%)
- assignments(15%)

Evaluation baseline

1. The degree to which the students comprehend and apply the studied content is evaluated via exams, quizzes, and dictogloss.
 2. The assignments are evaluated based on degree of completeness and application of the learned knowledge.
 3. Class participation is evaluated based on the students' attitudes during class and their active participation in the class activities.
- *70% minimum attendance is required for evaluation; those who fail to meet this mandatory requirement will be automatically graded "F"(fail).

Target students:

This is an advanced level Japanese course. Students who wish to register for this course must have completed a Japanese course at the upper intermediate level or obtained the 'Advanced Level' score on the GEC-JTest. Exchange students (Special auditing students) can register for this course.

Review and preparation

Prior study: reflect on your own learning experience and knowledge of the grammar topics under discussion. Read the material according to the instructions.

Post-learning: work on the assignments on the LMS according to the instructions. Also, be aware of what you have learned in class and use Japanese outside the classroom.

Kobe University requires 45 hours of study from students to award one credit, including both in-class instructions as well as study outside classes.

Students are required to prepare for each class and complete the review after each class, depending on the respective class goals.
