#### Lesson topic

This class aims to improve listening and conversation skills for introductory and elementary level students.

#### Lesson target

1. To be able to listen to information about yourself.
2. To be able to listen to information about things around you.
3. To be able to talk about yourself.
4. To be able to talk about things around you.

#### Syllabus and plan

As this class is held to follow "Elementary Japanese Listening and Speaking A", students are recommended to undertake both classes.

The class schedule is as follows:

- Class 1. 6/10 Greeting people and asking things
  - Class 2. 6/17 Continuing a conversation
  - Class 3. 6/24 Making inquiries about a lost article
  - Class 4. 7/1 Explaining things and asking a favor
  - Class 5. 7/8 Apologizing
  - Class 6. 7/15 Asking for permission
  - Class 7. 7/29 Summary, Final examination
  - Class 8. 8/5 Task-based assignment
- 8 classes (15 hours)

From the 2nd class to the 6th class, there will be a short listening test in each class. Please check the test contents during class.

\*The schedule may change according to the students' needs.

\*The syllabus may be revised subject to circumstance. Please keep yourself up-to-date with information provided in class.

#### Evaluation method

Your final grade will be calculated based on the following process:

1. Quizzes 20%
2. Assignments 20%
3. Final examination 50%
4. Class participation and performance in class 10%

\*70% minimum attendance is required for evaluation; those who fail to meet this mandatory requirement will be automatically graded "F"(fail).

#### Evaluation baseline

1. Students should be able to obtain basic listening and conversation skills required for everyday life in Japan.
2. Students should be able to differentiate speech levels (politeness and Keigo) appropriately depending on the situations and contexts.
3. Students should be able to hear out topics related to everyday situations and also be able to speak with proper pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar, and expressions.

#### Notice (include info. on related class)

This class is a elementary level Japanese class. Students who wish to register for this class are recommended to complete Elementary Japanese Listening and Speaking A, or obtained the "Beginner Level" score in the GEC-JTest.

#### Related classes:

It is recommended to take "Elementary Japanese Reading and Writing B" at the same time.

Before taking this class, it is recommended to take "Elementary Japanese Listening and Speaking A".

Exchange students (special auditing students) can register for this course.

#### Review and preparation

##### Preparation for the class:

Students are required to check vocabulary (meaning and pronunciations) before the class.

##### Review for the class:

1. Listen to the audio files and review them (a listening quiz will be given each time, and the scope of the quiz will be announced in class).
2. Students are encouraged to use phrase and expressions that have been covered in the class in daily conversation to improve their communication skills in Japanese.

Kobe University requires 45 hours of study from students to award one credit, including both in-class instructions as well as study outside classes.

Students are required to prepare for each class and complete the review after each class, depending on the respective class goals.
