Topic:

This course aims to teach 111 upper elementary level kanji and related vocabulary.

Lesson target

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

1. Read and write 111 upper elementary level kanji accurately.
2. Use approximately 500 kanji in total (including elementary and upper elementary levels) and related vocabulary appropriately in sentences.

Syllabus and plan

Course Format:

This course is conducted face to face.

The course format and syllabus may be revised depending on circumstances. Students are responsible for keeping up to date with announcements made in class.

Course Description and Schedule:

Students will study kanji, vocabulary, and their usage. At the beginning of each class, kanji reading and writing quizzes based on the previous lesson will be conducted. Assignments will also be given throughout the course.

Attendance alone is not sufficient to pass the course. Active participation and a minimum score of 60% on each quiz and exam are required.

Target Students:

This course is designed for upper elementary level Japanese learners.
Students are strongly recommended to have completed Elementary Japanese Kanji and Vocabulary AB or to possess equivalent proficiency (Upper Elementary level on the CIEJ Test).
Since this course assumes prior knowledge of elementary level kanji, students who have not yet reached this level are advised to take the elementary course first.

Related Courses:

Before taking this class, it is recommended that you take "Upper Elementary Japanese Kanji and Vocabulary A."

Exchange students (special auditing students) are eligible to register.

Review and preparation

Preparation and Review:

Students are required to study outside of class.
They must practice writing and review the kanji and vocabulary taught in class before the next lesson in preparation for quizzes.

Assignments must also be submitted as instructed.
