Lesson topic

Topic: This class aims to improve listening and speaking skills for intermediate level students.

Lesson target

【Course Objectives】

1. To develop accurate listening skills for daily conversation
2. To be able to use appropriate language for goal setting, situation description, and human relations
3. To learn expressions and vocabulary related to study topics

Syllabus and plan

We use a textbook and have lessons according to the schedule below.

Basically, students will study one topic for two of the lessons. We will confirm vocabulary, grammar and expressions and students will be given dictations, pair works or group works in order to improve their practical listening and speaking skills.

The class schedule is as follows:

Class 1 (6/15): How the trip was 1

Class 2 (6/22): How the trip was 2

Class 3 (6/29): Shopping 1

Class 4 (7/06): Shopping 2

Class 5 (7/13): Receiving compliments 1

Class 6 (7/22 *Wed.): Receiving compliments 2 ※Designated for Monday Courses

Class 7 (7/23): Summary and Examination

Class 8 (7/30): Task based assignment

The content of the classes, is subject to change after consultation with the students after the classes have begun.

1 class per week for 8 weeks

1 class = 15 hours per quarter

Evaluation method

Method of evaluation:

Students will be assessed on their performance in class, quiz and the final examination.

1. Class participation and performance in class:30%
2. Assignment 30%
3. Final examination 40%

Evaluation baseline

1. Class participation and performance in class:

Students are evaluated whether do practices and tasks that teacher conduct in class, and communicate with class participants through the those activities.

2. Assignments:

Points will be deducted from assignments if they are submitted late or not all done. Quizzes will be given.

3. Final examination:

Examination consists of the questions of vocabularies, listening and speaking tasks. Students are evaluated whether understand and use these contents.

*70% minimum attendance is required for evaluation; those who fail to meet this mandatory requirement will be automatically graded "F"(fail).

Target students:

This is an intermediate level Japanese course.

The teacher performs it only in Japanese, and, the students use only Japanese, too. Students who wish to register for this course should have completed a Japanese course at elementary level or obtained the 'Intermediate Level' score in the GEC-JTest.

Review and preparation

[Lesson Preparation]

1. Listening to the next conversation audio and understanding the content.
2. Completing the vocabulary quiz on BEEF+.

[Lesson Review]

1. Learn the expressions and vocabulary covered in class.
2. Shadow and practice the conversation presented in the CD.
