Evaluation method

Students will be assessed on participation, their performance in class and the final examination.

1. Class participation and performance in class 20%
2. Assingment 20%
3. Final examination 60%

*70% minimum attendance is required for evaluation; those who fail to meet this mandatory requirement will be automatically graded "F"(fail). Students are expected to attend the class at least three times a week.

Evaluation baseline

2. Assingment: Students are evaluated whether do every day's homework properly and submit by the due date.
