#### Lesson topic

This course focuses on current issues as well as social and cultural themes, with an emphasis on developing the ability to explain, discuss, and present topics of personal interest.

#### Lesson target

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

1. Provide clear and logical explanations of topics of personal interest.
2. Deliver presentations structured with audience awareness.
3. Demonstrate understanding of current, social, and cultural issues and discuss them effectively.
4. Use appropriate vocabulary and expressions necessary for discussion and presentation.
5. Apply communication strategies to manage interactional challenges.

#### Syllabus and plan

This course aims to develop students' ability to provide clear, detailed, and well-structured explanations of topics in which they have a current interest. It also seeks to cultivate the ability to present ideas in a manner that effectively engages the audience.

The course centers on discussions and presentations based on current issues and social or cultural themes. While selected readings and short audiovisual materials may be used when appropriate, the primary emphasis is placed on productive skills and interactive communication. Through these activities, students expand their range of relevant vocabulary and expressions and develop communication strategies for addressing interactional challenges.
