Lesson topic

This class aims to improve writing skill for upper intermediate level students.

Lesson target

- 1.To be able to explain the outline of your major field or field of interest with reference to materials.
- 2.To be able to write opinions on social issues in coherent sentences consisting of multiple paragraphs, based on the data and materials provided.
- 3.To be able to use conjunctions and modality forms up to upper intermediate level appropriately.

Syllabus and plan

This course is provided in face-to-face mode.

The class schedule is as below:

- Week 1 (June 10)Orientation; Conjunctions and Paragraph Organization
- Week 2 (June 17)Distinguishing between Similar Expressions
- Week 3 (June 24)Expressing the Connection between Past and Present
- Week 4 (July 1)Distinguishing between wa and ga
- Week 5 (July 8)Distinguishing Sentence-Final Expressions Used to Convey Meaning
- Week 6 (July 15)Using no da Constructions to Relate to the Previous Sentence
- Week 7 (July 29)Review and Examination
- Week 8 (August 5)Assignment

*The syllabus is subject to change. Students are responsible for confirming the latest information in class.

Evaluation method

Method of evaluation:

Students will be assessed on scores of the final examination, assignment, their participation and performance in class.

- ① Final examination:50%
- ② Assignment:40% (Assignments will be indicated in class)
- ③ Participation and performance in class:10%

Evaluation baseline

- 1.Final examination will be assessed based on whether students can write an essay with a logical structure using sentences and expressions learned in class.
- 2.Assignment will be assessed based on its implementation status and whether students can write essays about each topic using sentences and expressions learned in class.
- 3.Participation and performance in class will be assessed based on whether students can concentrate on class and contribute to the class activity.

*A minimum attendance rate of 70% is required as a prerequisite for grade evaluation. Students who do not meet this requirement will automatically receive an F (Fail).

Target Students:

This course is designed for upper-intermediate level learners.

It is intended for students who have completed intermediate-level Japanese study or who have been placed at the "upper-intermediate level" based on the GEC-JTest.

*Exchange students (special auditing students) are also eligible to enroll.

It is recommended that students complete "Japanese Writing Upper-Intermediate A" prior to enrolling in this course.

Review and preparation

Preview of the class:

Students should revise and self study on content or items highlighted in class.

Review of the class:

Students are required to revise what was covered in class, and submit assignments by their due dates. The assignments will be annotated and returned to students, and students are required to revise and correct their assignments for resubmission.

Kobe University requires 45 hours of study from students to award one credit, including both in-class instructions as well as study outside classes.

Students are required to prepare for each class and complete the review after each class, depending on the respective class goals.
