To be able to critically analyze and argue about different views of Japanese Culture and Society.

The details are as follows:

Students are to carry out an inquiry into modern social structures of Japan and their origins, via the use of fundamental knowledge gained from 'Japanese Studies I', and to enhance the knowledge needed for success in specialized fields of study or research.

In this class students will aim to recognize, observe and comprehend the various problems that lie latent in Japanese society that has experienced tremendous changes in a very short time since WWII; and at the same time study the future role or images that Japan should take or project in the international community.

The course schedule is as follows:

Class 1 6/16: Topic/Investigation method

Class 2 6/23: Questionnaire/Presentation creation

Class 3 6/30: Rehearsal and feedback

Class 4 7/7: Presentation

Class 5 7/14: Presentation

Class 6 7/21: Presentation

Class 7 7/28: Final exam

Class 8 8/4: Reflection, Feedback

1 class per week for 8 weeks

1 class = 15 hours per quarter

Evaluation method

1. Final exam 60%

2. Performance and presentation in the class 40%

*70% minimum attendance is required for evaluation; those who fail to meet this mandatory requirement will be automatically graded "F"(fail).

Evaluation baseline

Students should be able to critically analyze and argue about different views of Japanese Culture and Society.

Review and preparation

Students are required to preview vocabulary of each lesson before they come to class (materials will be provided). Students are also required to submit a review sheet provided in each class.

Kobe University requires 45 hours of study from students to award one credit, including both in-class instructions as well as study outside classes.

Students are required to prepare for each class and complete the review after each class, depending on the respective class goals.
