## Review and preparation

### Preview

- It is recommended to preview vocabulary before every lesson.

### Review

- Students are required to do a review sheet after every lesson. Students are also required to review the vocabulary and the sentence patterns with the example sentences to prepare for the quizzes.

Kobe University requires 45 hours of study from students to award one credit, including both in-class instructions as well as study outside classes. Students are required to prepare for each class and complete the review after each class, depending on the respective class goals.
